Recipe Corner

Cream of Corn Soup

2 lb cut fresh yellow corn off the cob 3 cups heavy cream

12 oz sliced white onion 2 cup water

2 oz butter 1 level teaspoon salt

Find the freshest corn you can and cut it off the cob making sure you scrape the cob to extract all of the milk. This is the sweetest part of the corn. Sauté the onions in a thick bottomed pan until soft but not brown. Add the rest of the ingredients and bring to a boil

Simmer for 10 minutes and remove from the heat. Place in a blender and puree till smooth. If the corn is not sweet you may add a little sugar to taste. This may be done ahead of time and kept warm in a double boiler.

Serves 6-8.

Cheese Fries

Submitted by Carla Rapps (from "The Roadtrip Cookbook")

1 bag fries, wedges, frozen 1 package cheese, shredded

1 tbsp chilli seasoning 1 onion, green, sliced

1 can chili 2 tbsp Sour Cream

- 1. Heat the grill to a medium heat.
- 2. In a bowl, combine the fries and chili seasoning toss to make sure the fries are well coated.
- 3. Add the fries to the grill (In aluminum foil or a grilling pan) and grill for abut 4 minutes. Turn and grill on the other side for 4 minutes.
- 4. While the fries are cooking, cook the chili in a medium-size saucepan and bring to a simmer.
- 5. Take the fries off the grill once they are cooked thoroughly.
- 6. Move the cooked fries to a serving dish and pour the cooked chili over the top of the fries.
- 7. Sprinkle shredded cheese and onion over the top of the shili. Top with sour cream.
