- The winner of the 50/50 was Gloria Hoehn who won \$59.

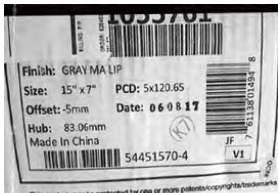

Recipe Corner

Smoked Ribs

Rib Rub

1 Cup sugar
 1/2 cup salt
 2 T Paprika
 2 T red pepper
 1 T cumin
 put in bowl & mix together

Barbecue sauce

1 cup sugar
 1/4 cup salt
 2 T celery seed
 2 T ground cumin
 2 T ground red pepper
 2 T garlic powder
 1 T chili powder
 2 quarts Ketchup
 2 Cups apple cider vinegar
 2 T liquid smoke
 1 t lemon juice

Instructions:

Soak wood chunks for 24 hours, Heat smoker temp to 280 F and smoke ribs for about 2 hours then take off smoker.

Use aluminum foil sheets and spray foil with cooking spray; then sift a coating of brown sugar and coating of liquid butter. Then place ribs on foil and repeat brown sugar and butter on top of ribs. You can use butter slices. then wrap and place back in smoker for 1 to 2 hours and they'll fall off the bone. Hope you enjoy

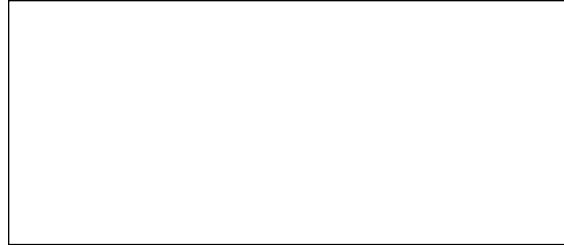
