4 cups frozen peas (about 16 ounces), thawed	1/2 cup ranch salad dressing	1/4 teaspoon pepper
1/2 cup shredded sharp cheddar cheese	1/3 cup chopped red onion	4 bacon strips, cooked and crumbled
	1/4 teaspoon salt	

1. Combine the first 6 ingredients; toss to coat.

  3. Refrigerate, covered, at least 1 hour.

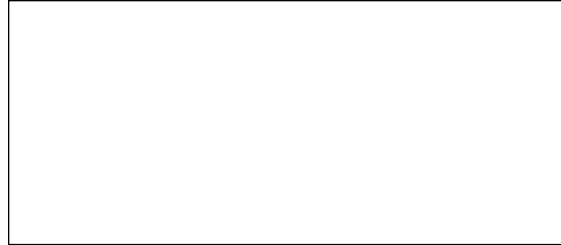
